



Campaign Update #9: Commission approves plat for new high school

An important step in building a new high school was realized on June 19 when the Burleigh County Commission signed off on the 48 acres for the future St. Mary's Central High School. The land was a generous donation from the Dr. Ron and Ruth Knutson family. The timeline for building the new school now depends on the progress of fund raising. We have currently raised more than \$8.5 million for our campaign, with the land donation not included in this total. It is hoped that we'll break ground in the fall of 2017, with the new SMCHS campus opening in the fall of 2019.
